


The Spirit of the Place

Art as Atmosphere



Can Alomar is as much a private gallery as it is a hotel. More than **40 curated works** by local and international artists — including **Jordi Alcaraz, Guillem Nadal, Roland Fischer, and Manolo Ballesteros** — are woven seamlessly into the building's spatial narrative. The art importantly does not decorate; **it activates**. Each piece introduces tension, curiosity, and dialogue, stimulating perception without demanding attention.

A defining moment awaits at arrival: a dramatic sculptural lamp by **Miguel Conde**, owner of IT Mallorca, crafted from antique glass by the master restorer of the Palma Cathedral's rose windows. It is both artwork and symbol — a convergence of heritage craftsmanship and contemporary vision, setting the tone for everything that follows.


Culinary Experience – A Destination in Itself


